**ABOUT THE CLUB**

Warwick Tennis Club is a small friendly club in attractive surroundings and is one of three Sections of Warwick Sports Club. The Sports Club also offers facilities for playing ladies' and men's hockey as well as cricket. The club is situated in Hampton Road opposite Warwick Racecourse. Membership is available for both senior and junior players of all standards and a social membership is also available for friends, partners and parents. A full coaching programme, using many coaching aids including a Ball Machine, is available for beginners and improvers. Contact names and numbers are given overleaf.

**Court Facilities**

Court facilities are excellent, comprising two hard courts and three artificial clay courts all of which have floodlights. The courts are available for use during daylight hours and up until 10.00pm every day of the year, subject to weather conditions. There are also changing, toilet and shower facilities within the Sports Club pavilion, although these are normally only available when the Pavilion has been opened by one of the Committee members or Team Captains. The courts are also available for hire to other clubs and to companies when not in use by the tennis club.

**Social Facilities**

The clubhouse bar is available for members' use and the clubhouse can be hired for private functions. Various social events are organised by the Committee and by the Sports Club throughout the year, details of which are given in the monthly newsletter and on the notice board in the clubhouse.

**Club Sessions**

There are three Adult Club sessions during the week which continue throughout the year at the following approximate times and are open to Adult Members, as well as Junior Members who have been recommended by the Coach and endorsed by the Committee:-

Wednesday - 7.00pm to 10.00pm

Friday - 7.00pm to 10.00pm

Sunday - 2.00pm to 5.00pm

Details of our Junior Club Night can be obtained from our Club Coach, Lianne Supperstone on 07919 104093, as they can change during the year.

Junior Members and Family Members are able to have priority use of one of the courts during the Sunday afternoon Club session.

**Coaching (separate fees apply)**

Regular coaching sessions are held throughout the year for Juniors of all standards, as well as for Adult beginners, improvers and team play. Individual coaching sessions for Adults and Juniors can also be arranged directly with the Club Coach, Lianne Supperstone on 07919 104093.

**Competition Play**

The club has three ladies' teams and three men's teams playing in the Coventry & District Lawn Tennis League during the summer months and three teams in the Banbury Mixed Winter League. Teams are chosen from the best players available at the time. There is also a small fee of £2.50 per League match for each player plus any costs for food and drink organised by the team captain.

Friendly fixtures are also arranged with other clubs during the season, thus enabling non-league players opportunity for competitive tennis as well. Other competitions and closed tournaments are also held during the year, especially on Bank Holidays. The Club championships take place in July.

The Club also has a Ladder competition offering intra-Club competitive play throughout the year for those that are interested.

A number of Junior tournaments are held during the year, as well as Mini Red, Orange and Green competitions with other clubs.

It is expected that after 3 visits to the club, the person should decide whether or not they wish to join the club as a member. Only in exceptional circumstances and agreed by the Committee would a player be allowed to continue to use the club facilities whilst only paying a visitor's fee.

Any Adult member who introduces a friend to the club and they become a full Adult member will receive a free tube of tennis balls.

When membership fees are paid each member will be issued with a shoe tag, which must be worn at all times when using the courts. The tag is a visible proof of current membership and players not wearing a current shoe tag may be asked to leave the courts or provide other proof of membership.

**Tennis Balls**

Members are expected to provide their own balls for Club sessions. With this in mind the Committee purchase tennis balls extra to league requirements and these are available for members to buy at a very competitive price.

## **WARWICK TENNIS CLUB**

### **CLUB RULES**

- 1. Annual Membership fees are due on 1 April each year and should be paid by 31 May. Existing members who have not paid by this date will be assumed to have lapsed their membership.**
- 2. Members should wear their shoe tag whilst on court to signify their membership. Players unable to produce a current tag may be asked to leave the courts.**
- 3. Members must wear suitable clothing for playing tennis whilst on the courts - Special attention must be paid to wearing tennis shoes to avoid injury and damage to the courts.**
- 4. Members must be courteous to each other at all times at the club and must avoid abusive language.**
- 5. Members must respect the privacy of those living close to the sports ground and avoid making undue noise.**
- 6. Members must avoid using the floodlights after 10.00pm**
- 7. Members must not abuse any tennis equipment belonging to themselves, other players or the club.**
- 8. Members must keep the courts, surrounding areas and clubhouse clean and tidy.**
- 9. The artificial clay courts must be swept after each session ready for use by the next players wishing to use the courts.**
- 10. Nets must be slacked when not in use to avoid undue stretching.**
- 11. Members must respect the times allocated to Adult and Junior club sessions. Only those juniors who have been invited by the Committee on the basis of ability will be allowed to play at the Adult club sessions. Such invitations will be revised each year.**
- 12. Any visitors to the club, wishing to play, must be accompanied by a member, who will be responsible for the visitor abiding by the Club Rules and for paying the visitor's fee to the Treasurer. No visitor (adult or junior) is allowed to play free of charge.**
- 13. New members must make a formal application to join the Tennis Club and have a proposer and seconder, who are already members of the Club. The application must be accompanied by an appropriately made out cheque to cover the membership fee. There must not be more than three 'visits' to the club before deciding whether or not to join.**
- 14. New members must ensure for their own safety and for the enjoyment of others that they are capable of entering into a tennis rally during the Club sessions and, if necessary, receiving sufficient coaching to achieve this standard.**
- 15. Where applicable, the LTA rules must be complied with during all times of tennis play.**
- 16. The rules of Warwick Sports Club must be complied with.**
- 17. The Committee shall ensure that it and the members abide by the Tennis Club's Constitution.**
- 18. In any matter of dispute within the Tennis Club that has to be referred to the Committee, the decision of the Committee is final.**
